* CLEVELAND RESIDENT CASE is defined as an individual who is classified as HIV or AIDS and was DIAGNOSED in Cuyahoga County and is believed to have been infected in the GREATER CLEVELAND AREA and is currently RESIDING IN CLEVELAND.

The Cleveland Area cumulative data are from 1980 through the month of this report.

Ohio cumulative data as of December 31, 2005 were obtained from the ODH HIV/AIDS Surveillance Unit. Ohio data reflect ages as of 12/31/2005.

**Rate: Living with HIV/AIDS rate is the number of persons living with HIV/AIDS per 100,000 population calculated using 2006 US Census for Cleveland (446,969) interpolated from the 2005 estimate of 452,208 from the Population Estimate Program of the US Census bureau. Census levels for subgroups are proportional to those reported in the 2000 Census. Dash or hyphen indicates no cases were reported for the given category.

Asterisk incidence rates are not calculated because census rate is not applicable to the respective category.
